Study Week - A new concept for Accelerated Learning



The Study Week is a 5 day (residential or day only) course. The days are split in two, with a ½ day (3 to 4 hours) being for your tuition and the other ½ day is for you to practice what you learnt, watch another's lessons or relax with a ride around the property, or maybe sit by the river and watch the water bubble by.

The lessons will be in small groups (max 6) so you receive all the individual attention you need to progress. Each session will probably be multi-level, though all participants will have already attended at least the introductory ground and ridden weekend courses. The excellent benefit of

multi-level sessions is that you are able to witness how tasks and patterns apply at different Certificates.

The lessons will have a focus for the week, though any area can be discussed and looked into as time and the group permit. If a group would like to concentrate on a particular theme, this can be catered for too.

Accommodation is available on-site in bunk rooms of 3 people to a room. Amenities consist of 3 bathrooms, each with a shower, toilet and basin. On-site camping is also an option if you prefer. Accommodation and Board Fees

The cost for food is \$60.00 per person per day - this is 3 meals per day x 5.5 days (\$345 per person).

The break-up for meals is breakfast - \$10; lunch \$15; dinner \$35 (2 courses & drinks).
